A 2-year program open to junior and senior Psychology majors with a gpa of 3.5 in psychology courses taken and an overall gpa of 3.2. Students who plan on graduating in 4 years apply at the end of their 2nd year while students taking 5 years usually apply at the end of their 3rd year. Transfer student applications will be accepted until September 1, 2006.
• Must submit a 2-4 page essay explaining interest in being part of the honors program and a copy of the student's transcript
• Students are given the opportunity to carry out research with a faculty member and write a thesis paper in the last year.

Provides academic, social, and informal functions for students who share an interest in Psychology. Residents are given the chance to participate in workshops and listen to guest speakers throughout the school year.
